The political landscape is rapidly changing. Compromise is now a four-letter word, and current members of Congress who dare reach across the aisle in the hopes of completing Congress' work are often punished by facing a challenger in their primary election. Long-supported candidates have both high expectations of our support and new fears of super PAC-supported challengers. Facing an ongoing uphill fundraising battle, how do we persuade more of our members to participate as NARFE-PAC donors?

The quarterly NARFE-PAC Contribution report is attached. In this document, you can see how each chapter in NC's federation performed during the first six months of the 2013-2014 election cycle. Also attached are the national and regional summaries of NARFE-PAC donations covering the first six months of the cycle. Shown here is a comparison of the first six months of the current cycle and the two prior cycles.
